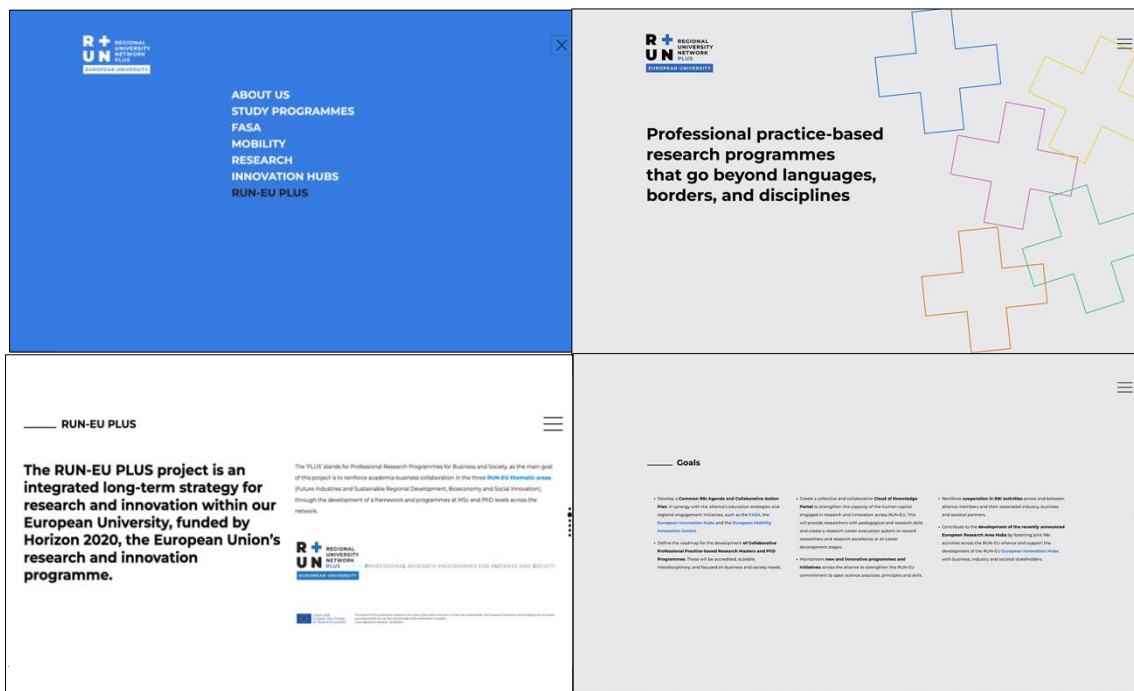


Figure 1 - Screenshots from website

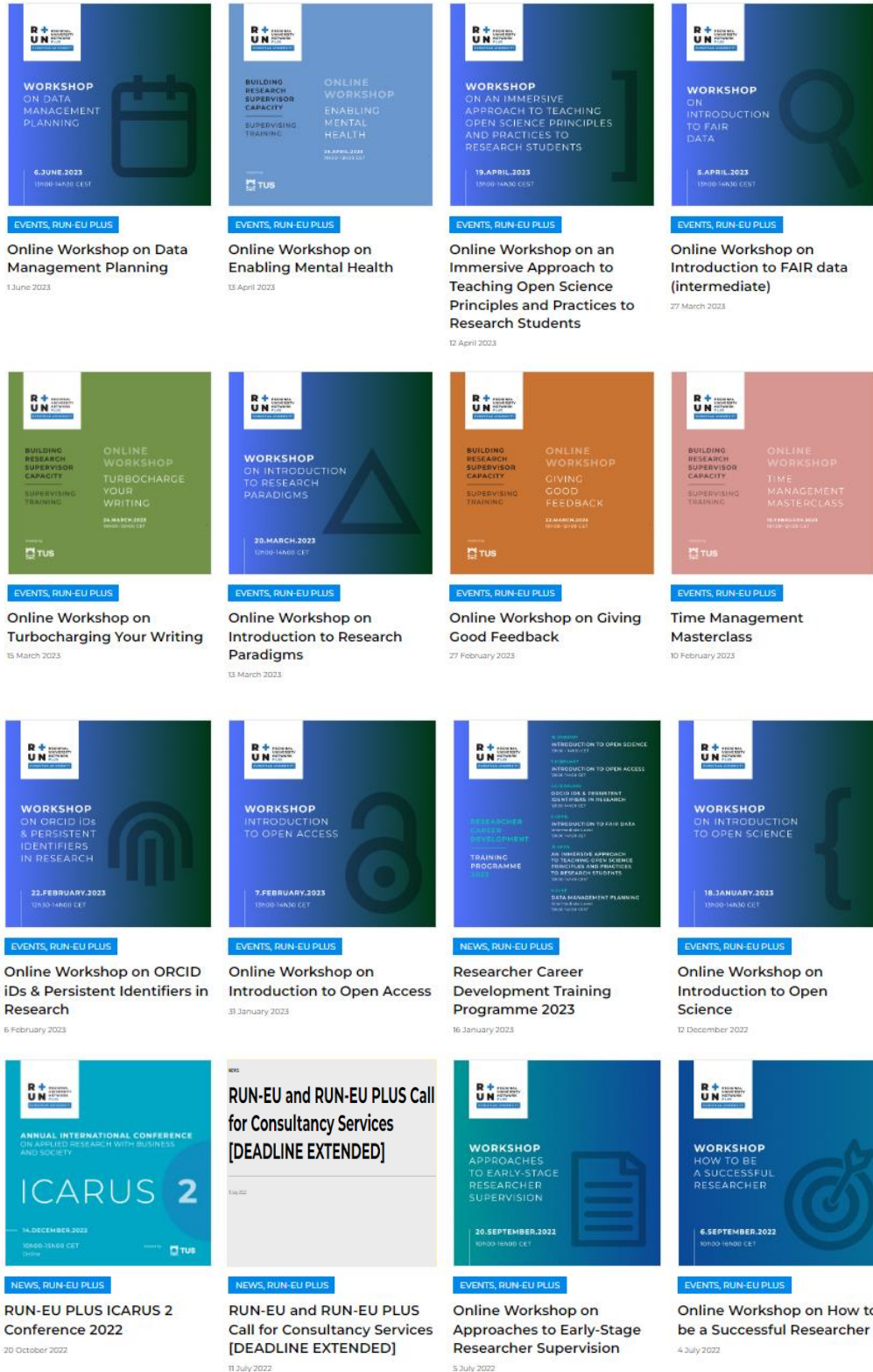


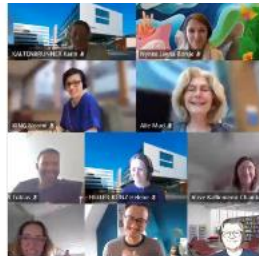
Figure 2 - Screenshots from online workshop event promotions

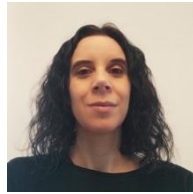


## 1.2 Introduction to RUN-EU PLUS Members

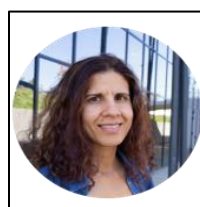

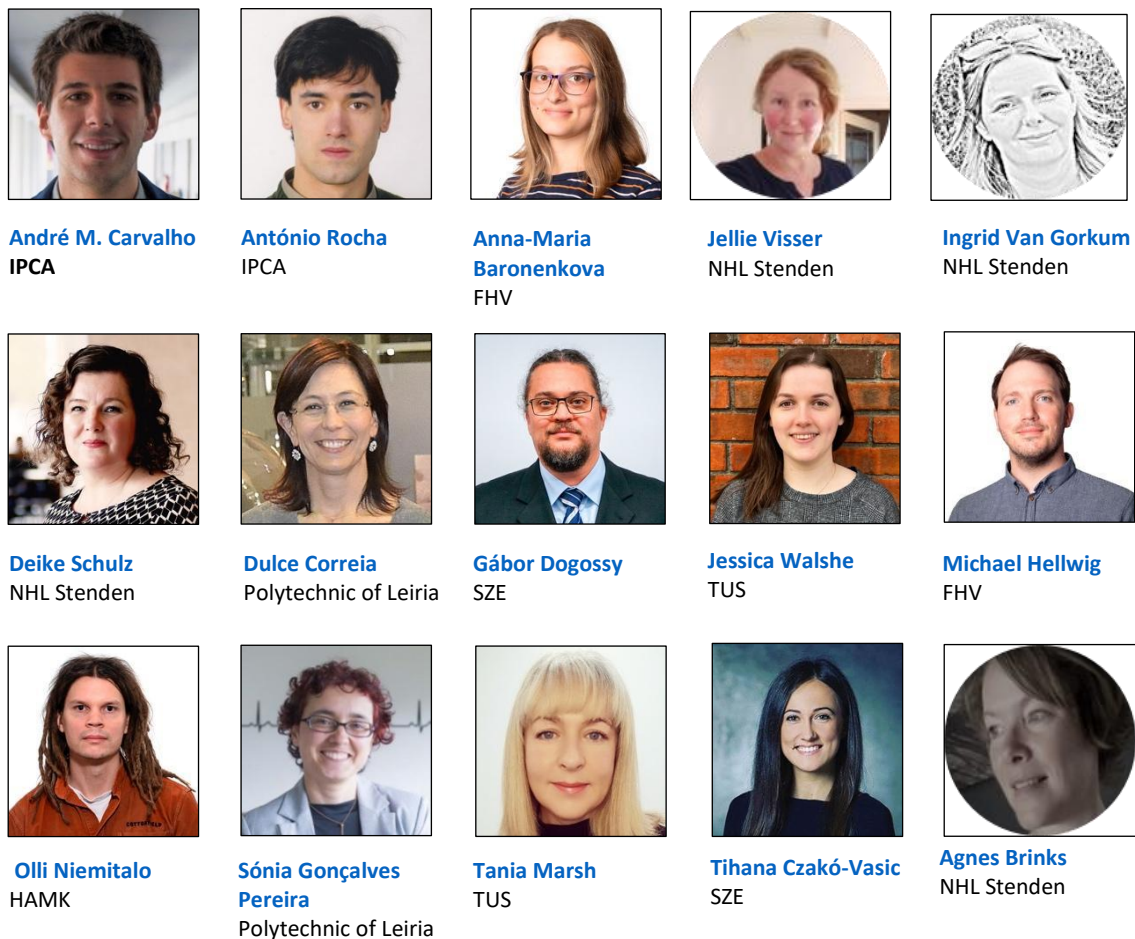
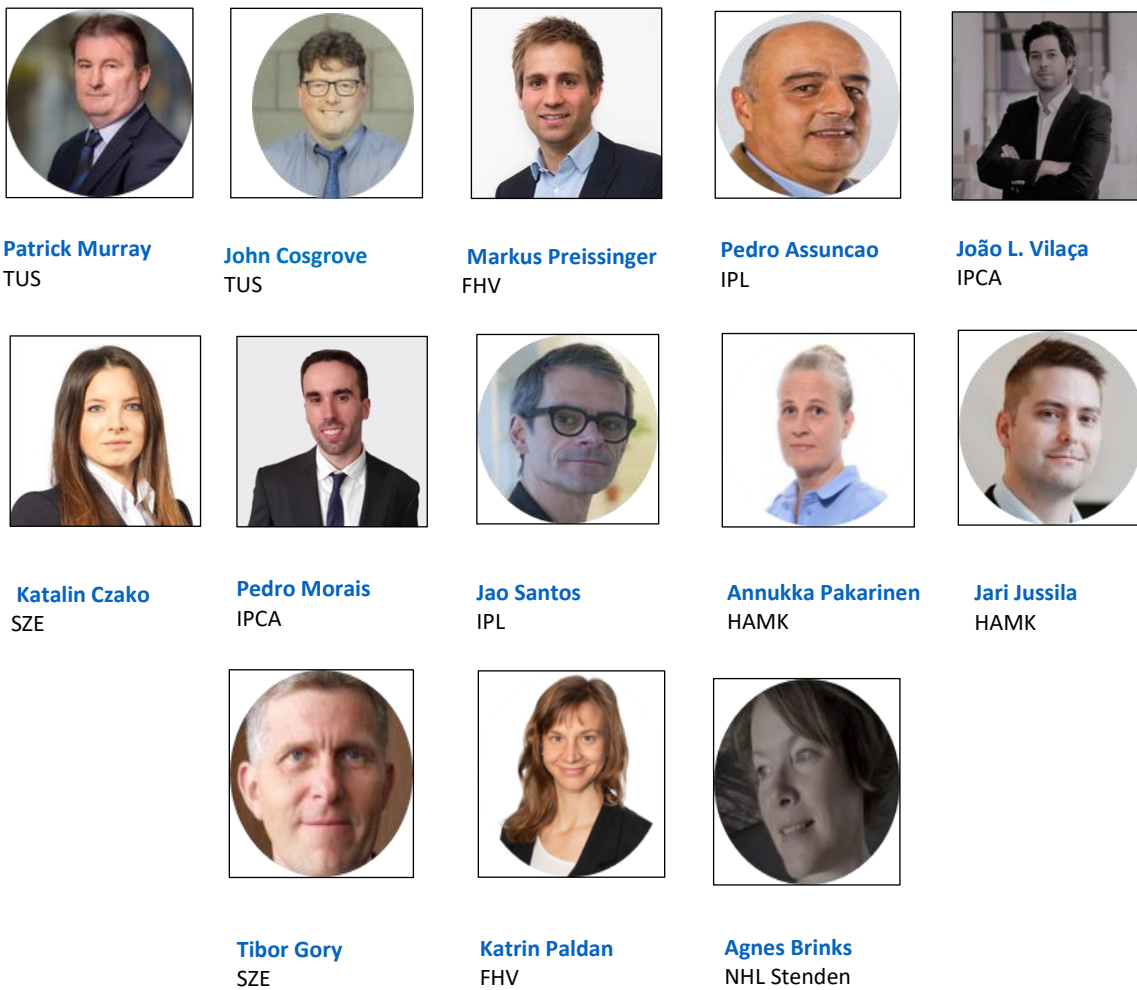


Figure 6 - Open Science Ambassadors

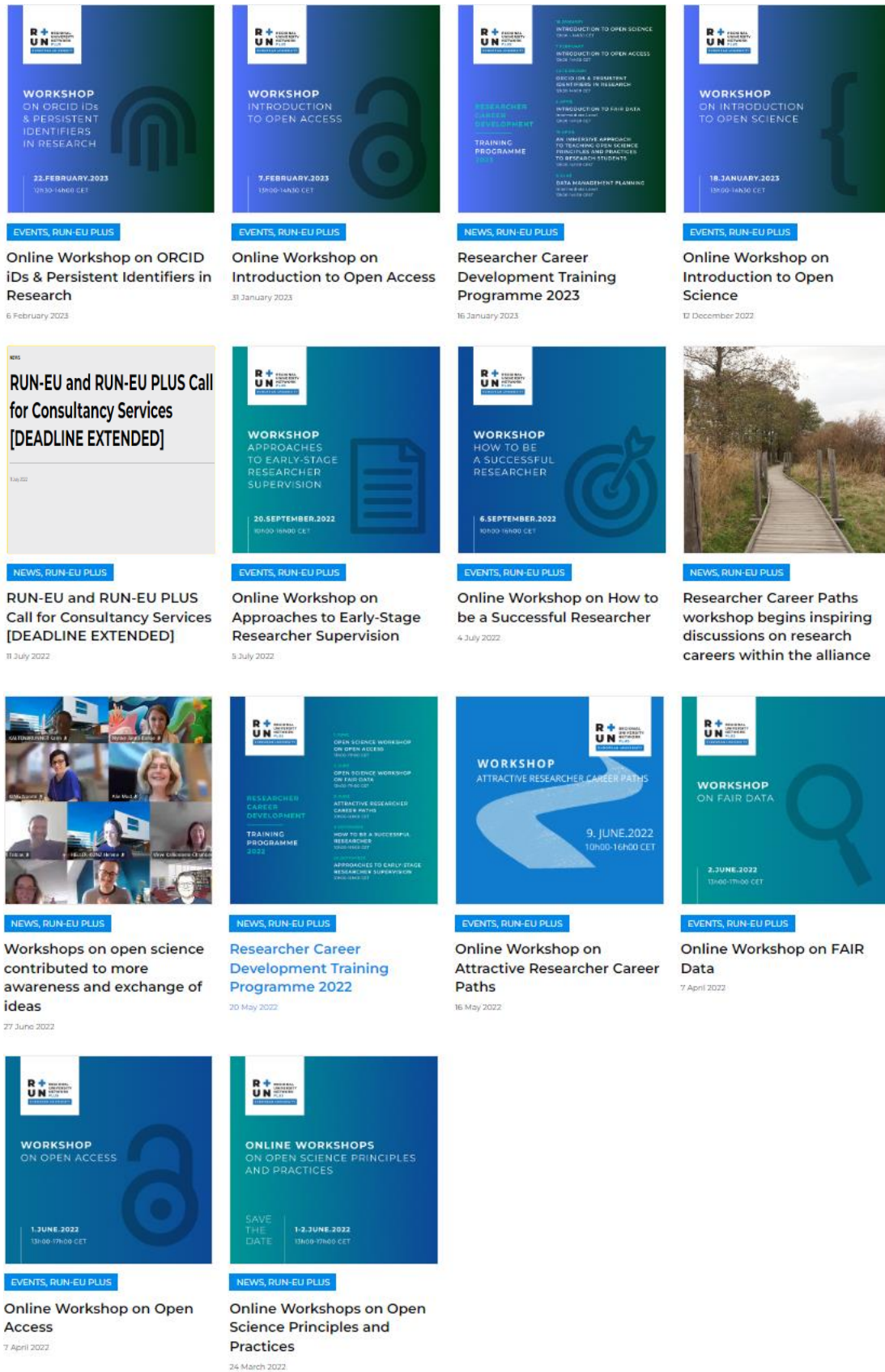


Figure 8 - RUN EU PLUS Workshops

### 1.4.2 Open Science Workshop Programmes

As part of the RUN-EU PLUS project and its Researcher Career Development Training Programme, two online workshops on open science principles and practices took place in June.

They were provided by Häme University of Applied Sciences (HAMK), University of Győr – Széchenyi István University (SZE), Polytechnic of Leiria, and NHL Stenden University of Applied Sciences (NHL Stenden) and aimed to introduce everyone to Open Access, Research Data Management, and FAIR (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable) Data.

Open Science is the movement that wants all research publications (whether data, logs, or articles) to be made public, used by everyone, and even republished (publicly) on other platforms. Of course, not all data can just be published. It is all about the principle of open publication if possible, keeping it closed if necessary.

The RUN-EU PLUS Online Workshop on Open Access reached 90 participants and the Online Workshop on FAIR Data was attended by 92 people. All feedback received was positive.

Communication of these events was completed through webpage, emailing and social media via RUN-EU tags and dissemination of outputs via screen capture publication and videos of presentations. **Section 1.4.1.1** illustrates the design of ‘Save the Date’ and final notification banners and mailing content used for communication to our alliance network about the events while **Section 1.4.1.2** illustrates the dissemination outputs gathered.

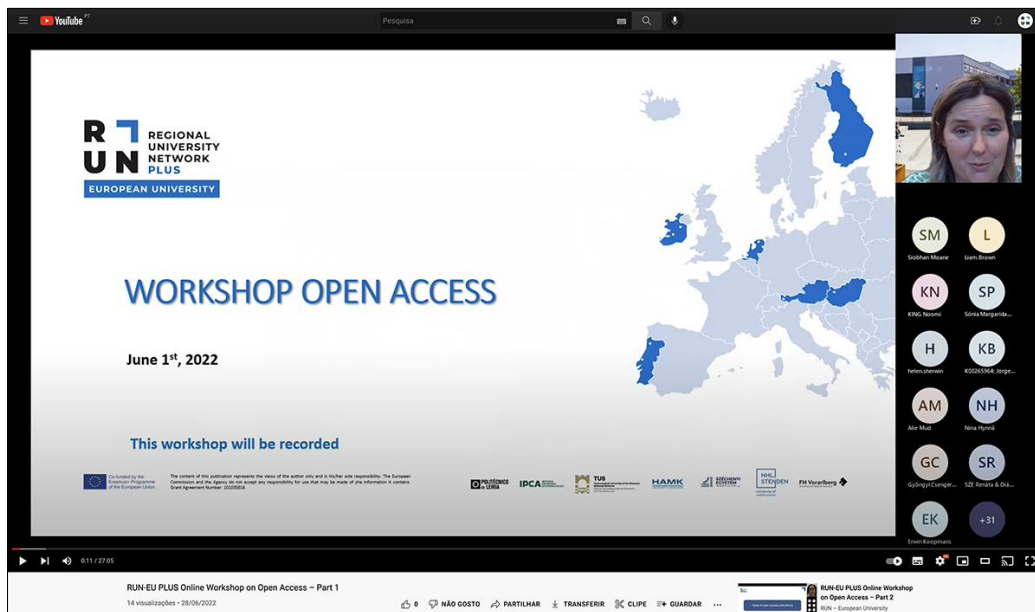




Figure 12 - RUN EU PLUS Workshop Banners

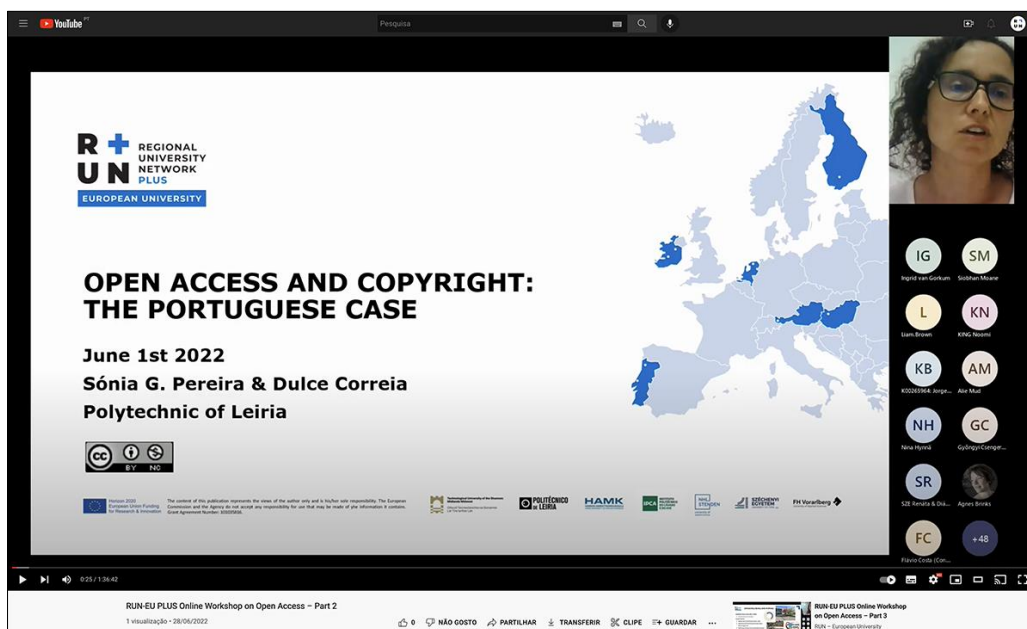

A demonstration on how to create, populate and link your very own ORCID profile to other profiles will be provided, along with scheduled time during the workshop to allow you to get started, or build on, your existing ORCID profile.

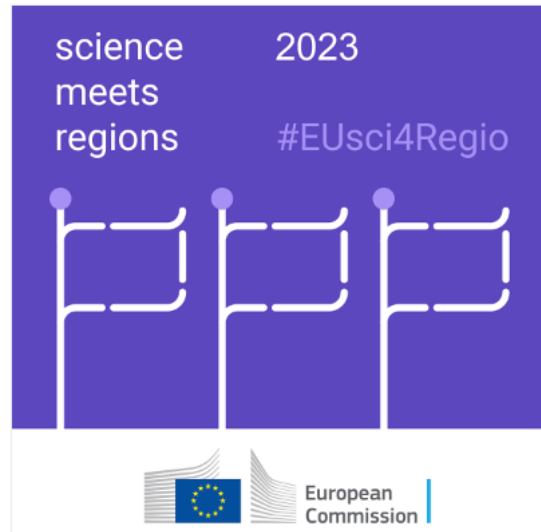

#### 1.4.8 Attractive Researcher Career Path Workshop Programme

As part of the RUN-EU PLUS Researcher Career Development Training Programme 2023, a Workshop on Attractive Researcher Career Paths took place on 18 January, 7 February, 22 February, 5 April, 19 April, and 6 June 2023.

The workshop gathered 54 RUN-EU researchers at different researcher career stages from across the alliance – those supporting researchers and those considering a career as a researcher.

Dr Siobhán Moane (RUN-EU PLUS Project Manager, TUS) describes the workshop as a great space and time for researchers to meet new colleagues within their European University and to discuss researcher career matters that participants had identified during the workshop registration process. In the morning, presentations focused on information on European goals for researcher careers and how to strengthen research career opportunities within the consortium universities.

Critical topics and challenges regarding researcher career paths were discussed in smaller groups during breakout room sessions. Before the workshop, participants had received a self-audit report on the researcher's career paths undertaken by RUN-EU PLUS as the workshop pre-material. The themes and gaps identified in the report became more "alive" when the researchers shared the challenges they experienced in constructing continuity in their careers.

The event encouraged participants to assess their research skills and identify their training needs. In the afternoon, short presentations on community-based practice research, on research collaboration with enterprises including intellectual property questions, and storytelling as an example of science communication, were all referring to the large variety of skills that researchers use in building their research impact in science and society.

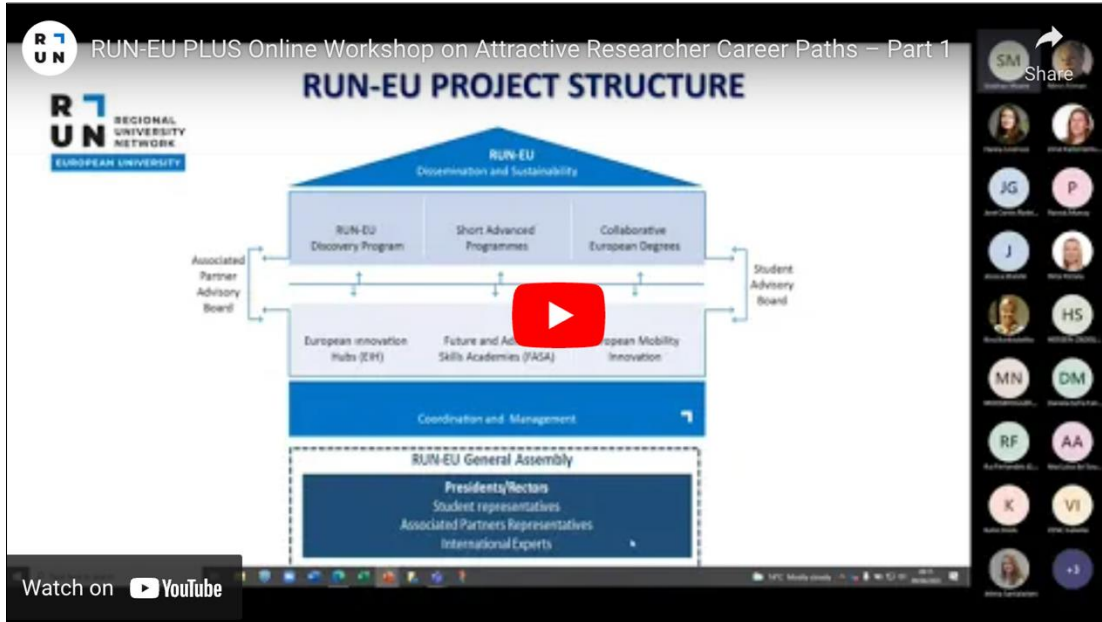

Figure 15 - Career Development Banner

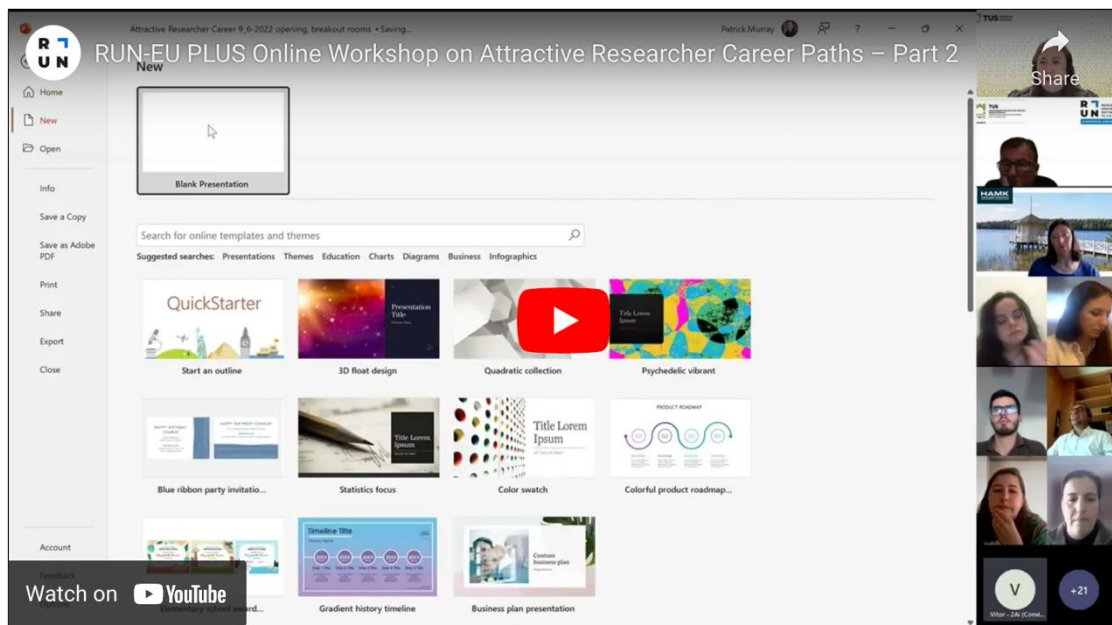

### 1.5 ICARUS December 2022

ICARUS 2 was the second annual International Conference on Applied Research with Business and Society of our RUN-EU PLUS project and is hosted by the Technological University of the Shannon: Midlands Midwest. The inaugural conference was held in December 2021 when the RUN-EU PLUS project was just over 2 months old. The December 2022 conference showcased researcher mobility and research collaborations across the RUN European University network and with our regional partners in their strategic priority research areas of sustainability, digitalisation, and social innovation. The Horizon 2020

RUN-EU PLUS project (grant agreement 101035816) supports our RUN European University in its regional development goals by focusing on the strengthening of regional business and society partnerships in research and innovation across our RUN network. RUN-EU PLUS is developing professional practice-based research master’s and doctoral programmes for business and society which will complement the existing RUN-EU strategic

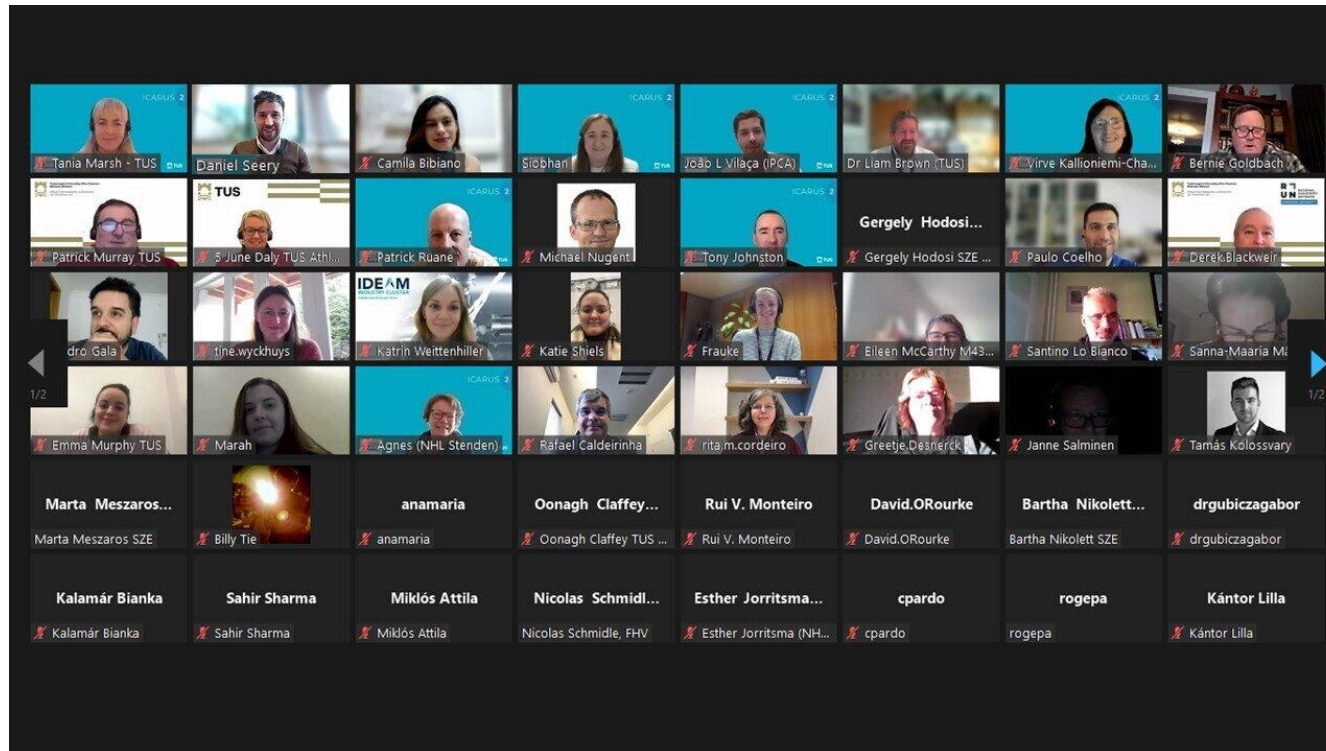

Figure 18 - ICARUS 2 Screenshots



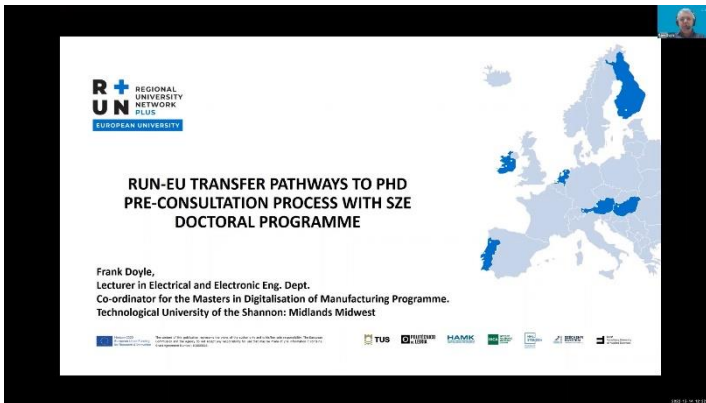
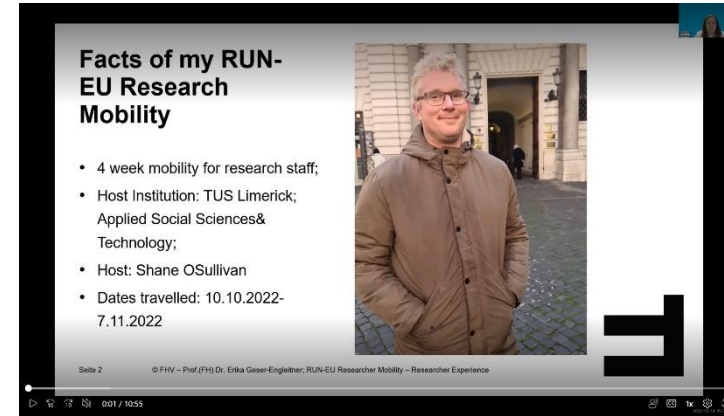


Figure 19 - ICARUS 2 Screenshots

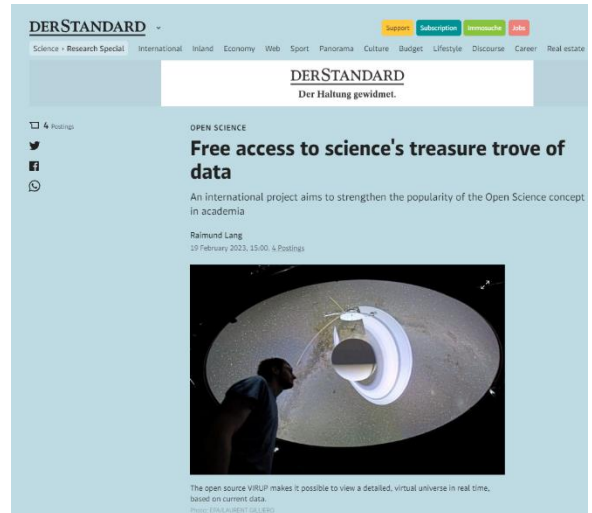


Figure 20 - National publication in Austria
